

SHELTER PERMIT POLICY

PROHIBITED USES OF PICNIC SHELTERS

The following uses shall not be allowed in picnic shelters:

- 1. Weddings and wedding receptions.**
- 2. Bands and sound systems.**
- 3. Erection of tents and canopies.**
- 4. Use of generators.**
- 5. Conducting animal rides.**
- 6. Use of carriages**
- 7. Utilization of caterers.**
- 8. Inflatable jump houses.**
- 9. NO dogs allowed.**
- 10. Personal sanitary facilities. (i.e., portable toilets)**
- 11. Any use of the park area which is not a customary use for a park in the Town of Cheektowaga shall receive the prior written approval of the Director of the Facilities Department.**
- 12. NO REFUNDS**

SHELTER OCCUPANCY LIMITS

Maximum of 50 people per shelter allowed.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND BEVERAGE CONTAINERS

1. Only beer, wine and wine coolers are allowed in picnic shelters, no other alcohol or liquor is permitted.
2. Keg beer is permitted.
3. No glass containers are allowed.

PARKING

1. Picnic shelter patrons must park in designated parking area.
2. Parking is prohibited on lawn areas.

POOLS

1. This shelter does not afford free access to Town pools. For pool use and information you can call 897-7207.

FUNDRAISING VENTURES

1. Subject to prior approval via Town Board resolution, not-for-profit/charitable organizations may conduct fundraising in a picnic shelter. Such not-for-profit/charitable organization must assure the Town that all labor, material and utility expenses will be borne by such organization. Such organization shall provide the Town with:
 - a. A list of its officers
 - b. A financial statement
 - c. A statement as to the percentage of funds to be directed to the organization
 - d. A statement as to the purpose of the event

BUSINESS PICNICS

Only businesses which have a permanent base of operations in the Town of Cheektowaga and employ 50 or more people in its Town facilities may apply for a picnic shelter permit. An employee of such business who is a Town resident must obtain the permit.
