Whereas the said moneys have not yet all been collected and it is necessary to borrow the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to pay the balance of said note which becomes due April 2nd 1908 now therefore Resolved that the Supervisor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue a note of the Town of Cheektowaga for the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to secure payment of said sum such note to be dated April 2nd 1908 to be payable one month from the date thereof with interest at the rate of six per cent per annum the proceeds thereof to be used to pay the balance of the said note above mentioned due April 2nd 1908

Resolution offered by Mr. Wildy Whereas the Town of Cheektowaga did cause to be constructed a system of services in Walden Ave Randolph Street Bowery Street Pine Hill Road Waverly Street Rugby Ave Woodell Ave and Cushing Ave and

Whereas the expense of such construction including the necessary was \$1500.00 and

Whereas there remains unpaid for the construction thereof the sum of \$1500.00

Now therefore resolved that the Supervisor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to borrow the sum of \$1500.00 to pay the balance due upon said sewer construction and the supervisor and Town Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to issue a certificate of indebtedness of the Town of Cheektowaga for said sum of \$1500.00 payable not more than six months from the date thereof with Interest thereon not exceeding six per cent per annum and apply the proceeds thereof to the payment of the expense of constructing said sewer system
