Meeting was called in the Sewer Proposition and the following Preamble and resolution or order was adopted.

Whereas a written Petition dated August 15th, 1911, has been presented to the Town Board of the Town of Cheektowaga praying that all those Lands situate in the Town of Cheektowaga. County of Erie and State of New York bounded and described as follows.

Commencing at the Northeasterly corner of the Village of Sloan being at the point of Intersection between the center line of Broadway and the center line of Harlem Avenue; thence running easterly along the center line of Broadway to the center line of Ludwig Avenue thence southerly along the line of Ludwig Avenue to the center line of William Street thence westerly along the center line of William Street to the westerly line of the lands of the Niagara, Lockport and Ontario Power Company thence southerly -along the Westerly line of said Power Company's lands to the Southerly boundary line of the Town of Cheektowaga, at the center of Cayuga Creek; thence westerly along the center of Cayuga Creek to the center line of Clinton Street thence westerly along the center line of Clinton Street to the easterly boundary line of the City of Buffalo thence northerly along said easterly Boundary line of the City of Buffalo to the center line of William Street thence easterly along said center line of William Street to the center line of Harlem Avenue thence northerly along said center line of Harlem to the point of beginning excepting however from the lands above described so much thereof as are now included in the Cochrane Street Sewer District, so called be erected into and established as a Sewer District and that a sewerage system be constructed and maintained in accordance with the plans therefor heretofore adopted by this Board and now on file in the Office of the Town Clerk of this Town and-

Whereas the estimated expense of constructing and putting into operation the entire system proposed to be established, including main and lateral sewers treatment beds - and disposal plant, will be approximately Two Hundred Seventy Five Thousand (\$275,000.00) Dollars and the estimated expense of constructing and putting into operation that portion of the proposal system consisting of main sewers only in Harlem Avenue William Street Helen Street and Cayuga Creek or Sulphur Springs Road with the necessary treatment beds disposal plant and site therefore will be approximately One Hundred (\$100,000.00) Dollars now therefore be it -

Resolved that the said petition be received and placed on file and be it further

Resolved that this Board meet at the Town Hall of the Town of Cheektowaga at Broadway and Union in said Town on the 4th day of March 1912 at 4 o'clock in the afternoon for the purpose of considering the said Petition and hearing all persons interested in the subject thereof concerning same and be it further -

Resolved that the Clerk of this Board be and he is hereby directed to give due notice of the time and place of said meeting in the manner prescribed by Law. Adopted

All that tract or parcel of land situate in the Town of Cheektowaga County of Erie and State of New York.

Resolved that this board decide and it does hereby decide to establish a system of sewers in said sewer district with treatment beds and disposal plant on the north side of Buffalo Creek in the Town of West Seneca as outlined upon the 29th day of March 1912 it being provided however that for the present this board cause to be constructed that portion only of said sewerage system which shall consist of main sewers in Harlem Avenue from the point therein where the southerly approach to the proposed viaduct over the Lehigh and Lake Erie Lehigh Valley Erie and Lackawanna Railroads will commence according to the plans therefore prepared by the Engineer of the Delaware Lackawanna and Western Railroad Company to the southerly terminus of said Harlem Avenue ; in William Street from said Ludwig Avenue westerly to a point therein distant sixteen hundred feet westerly from the center line of Harlem Avenue and in Cayuga Creek or Sulphur Springs Road from the Westerly line of the right of way of Niagara Lockport Ontario Power Company to the westerly terminus of said road; in Helen Street from William Street to Cayuga Creek for Sulphur Springs Road and the extension of said sewerage system from the westerly terminus of said Cayuga Creek or Sulphur Springs Road up to and into the disposal plant on the north side of Buffalo Creek upon site hereinbefore refused to and be it further

Resolved that the Supervisor be and he is hereby directed to notify Evangelical Lutheran Saint John's Orphan Home, in writing that the Town of Cheektowaga elects to purchase the lands described in the option heretofore given by said Orphan Home to the Town of Cheektowaga and extending from Clinton Street to the center of Buffalo Creek in the Town of West Seneca, Erie County New York for use as a site for the treatment beds and disposal plant to be constructed as a part of the sewerage system to be established in Sewer District number Three and be it further

Resolved that the Town Engineer and Surveyor be and he is hereby directed to make definite plans and specifications for the construction of said sewers in Harlem Avenue from the point where the southerly approach to the proposed Viaduct over the Lehigh and Lake Erie, Lehigh Valley, Erie and Lackawanna Railroads will commence according to plans therefor prepared by the Engineer of Delaware Lackawanna and Western Railroad Company to the southerly terminus of said Harlem Avenue in William Street from Ludwig Avenue westerly to a point therein distant sixteen hundred feet westerly from the center line of Harlem Avenue and in Sulphur Springs Road or Cayuga Creek road from the westerly line of the right of way of Niagara Lockport and Ontario Power Company to the westerly terminus of said road up to and into the disposal plant and in Helen Street from William Street to the Sulphur Springs or Cayuga Creek Road and for the construction of the treatment beds and disposal plans on Buffalo Creek upon the aforesaid site and a careful estimate of the expense of said construction and of each part thereof and he is further directed to prepare with the assistance of and in a form approved by the attorney for this board a proposed Contract for the execution of the work necessary to be done to construct the aforesaid portion of said sewerage system and to file the same with the Town Clerk of the Town of Cheektowaga on or before the 12th day of April 1912. And be it further

Resolved that this board meet at the Residence of Michael Bitterman on Walden Avenue in the Town of Cheektowaga on the 12th day of April 1912 at 3 o'clock in the afternoon for the purpose of considering the aforesaid plans specifications and contract ad for the purpose of transacting such other business as shall be proper. Adopted

Moved by Brennan seconded by Monin that this Board adjourns . Carried.
