ITINERARY

Day 1: Home City ~ Warther's Carvings ~ Holmes County ~ Amish Dinner & Show:

Travel aboard a deluxe highway touring motorcoach into the heart of Ohio's Amish country. As we travel rest and meal stops will be made periodically. By early afternoon we arrive at Warther's Carvings, Gardens and Knife Shop for an amazing tour of the priceless works of World's Master Carver, Mooney Warther. Tour the button house with over 70,000 buttons arranged in artwork, stroll the beautiful Swiss gardens and visit the family cutlery factory and gift shop. Later today we arrive at the lovely Carlisle Inn Sugarcreek for a delightful two-night stay. Gather for dinner followed by a show at the hotel.

Day 2: Baltic Mill ~ Sugarcreek ~ Berlin ~ Heini Cheese ~ Flea Market: Following breakfast we embark on a scenic drive through the placid Amish farmlands of Holmes County. Stop at Baltic Mill, an old fashioned grist mill which grinds their own cornmeal, flour, pancake and bread machine mixes. Later this morning we visit Sugarcreek, known as "Little Switzerland of Ohio" because of its Swiss settlers and architecture. Continue on to Walnut Creek and enjoy free time to explore Colbentz Chocolate Company, Carlisle Gift Store and the local bakery. Later today arrive in the town of Berlin where we will have ample time to have lunch on own and visit the many shops and boutiques of this quaint village. A stop will also be made at Heini's Cheese Chalet for a guided tour and free sampling. Later today enjoy free time to stroll the Flea Market which features over 400 vendors under roof. This evening we enjoy dinner at an Amish home for a wedding style feast.

Day 3: Cleveland Sights ~ Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad ~ Westside Market ~ Journey

Home: After breakfast we travel to Cleveland and the North Coast of Ohio. Arrive in the charming village of Peninsula and board the Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad for a relaxing and scenic train ride to Independence. Our route takes us directly through the heart of Cuyahoga Valley National Park. This rail excursion is filled with fun, excitement, natural beauty and historic sights. You'll ride comfortably in vintage climate-controlled coaches built between 1939 and 1940. After the train ride re-board our coach and transfer to Cleveland's authentic old-world style Westside Market and enjoy free time for lunch and shopping on own. Later this afternoon we embark on a guided city tour which will include the Old Arcade, the Flats, Jacobs Field, Severance Hall, downtown, the Lake Erie waterfront, Rock N Roll Hall of Fame, the historic Warehouse District and University Circle. Later today we depart for home.
