WHY RECYCLING CORRECTLY IS SO IMPORTANT

The recycling process is a shared responsibility between Modern as your processor and you as the resident. The quality of the materials placed in your carts/totes for recycling is now more important than ever. Placing unacceptable items in your recycle carts/totes will result in them being thrown away as trash, which will then result in costs paid for by tax dollars. The costs incurred to remove and dispose of unacceptable items from recycling facilities has a negative impact on municipalities everywhere.

Curbside recycling programs are designed to redirect routinely found and commonly used items in your home. The recycling menu in this newsletter features the best items to recycle.

Curbside recycling carts/totes should never be used to dispose of clothing, pillows, carpeting, lumber, car parts or furniture. These items are not acceptable for curbside recycling. There are many local resources available to donate, reuse or dispose of items you no longer need. Contact your municipality to find these outlets designed to help you recycle or reuse these materials responsibly within your community.



REDUCE WASTE AND IMPROVE RECYCLING EFFORTS

- Place items in your recycle cart that are on the current menu of **best items to recycle**.
- Be sure items purchased can be recycled, reused or returned to the manufacturer.
- Buy in bulk to save on packaging and purchase items in minimal packaging.
- Source food locally through food cooperatives or community gardens.
- Borrow or rent items you only need once.
- Use multiple reusable grocery bags.
- Donate furniture and clothing.
- Compost food scraps.
- Mulch grass.

TIPS TO HELP IN COLLECTION



WHEN TO PUT YOUR CARTS OUT?

Collection times can vary, so please have your waste and recycling to the street's edge by 6:00 a.m. the day of collection to ensure your material is collected. If collection crews pass your home and your material is not out, you will need to wait until the next week for collection or pay a fee to have the truck return.

HOW SHOULD YOU FILL YOUR CARTS?

Waste and recycling carts/totes provide a convenient way to handle your weekly accumulation of material. Please follow your community's guidelines for proper placement of material. This will ensure that you don't receive a service rejection notice or "Oops" tag. If you receive an "Oops" tag, they will indicate the reason(s) your material was not collected.

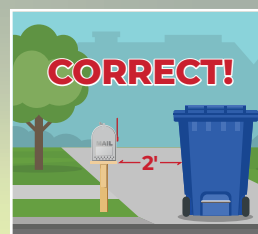
Please do not jam or over pack materials into carts/totes. The materials may get stuck and not come out when the carts/totes are tipped. Lids must be closed to prevent your materials from blowing out, water and snow from getting in, and unwanted rodents from being a nuisance. Material exceeding the designated height of the cart may result in an "Oops" tag. Recycling materials must be placed loose in recycle carts/totes. There is no need to sort or contain loose material in a bag of any kind when you place it in your carts/totes.

Any additional cardboard that will not fit into the tote should be leaned next to the recycling tote. This cardboard is required to be broken down and bundled/tied into bundles that will fit inside the tote.

CART POSITION:

Place your waste and recycling carts/totes on a level surface at the street's edge. **Your trash tote handle should face the street and your recycling tote handle should face the house.**

Please keep at least **2 feet of space** between each of your carts/totes as well as other fixed objects, such as mailboxes.
