Taxes may be voluntarily paid without fees or additions by

**October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024 Inclusive**

After which the following schedule will become effective:

**October 16<sup>th</sup> thru October 31<sup>st</sup> 7.5%**

**November 1<sup>st</sup> thru December 2<sup>nd</sup> 9.0%**

For further convenience, in addition to the regular office hours, this office will be open:

**Tuesday, October 15<sup>th</sup> 4:15 to 9pm**

On December 1, a transcript of all unpaid School taxes will be filed with the DIRECTOR OF BUDGET, FINANCE AND MANAGEMENT, COUNTY OF ERIE, 95 FRANKLIN STREET, BUFFALO, NEW YORK, to be re-spread on the 2025 COUNTY TAX ROLL AT 10.5% additional.

For all property owners of residential property, please note you may be eligible for senior citizens tax exemptions. The Town of Cheektowaga, Erie County, Cheektowaga Central School, Maryvale Union Free School, Cleveland Hill Union Free, Depew Union Free School, Cheektowaga, Sloan, Lancaster Central School, West Seneca Central School, Williamsville Central School all offer exemptions for low-income seniors.

Property owners must own and live in the home as the primary, legal residence, be aged 65 by December 31, 2024 and have a household, combined income of less than \$48,399.

Each taxing jurisdiction has different income limits but household incomes below \$48,399 will qualify for an exemption under Real Property Tax Law 467.

Senior citizens have until March 1, 2025 to apply for such exemptions.
