ALL chart information is based upon standards effective October 1, 2023.

The following documents are required (if applicable) to apply for SNAP:

- **PROOF OF IDENTITY** (photo ID/ Social Security card)
- **PROOF OF SHELTER EXPENSES** (utility bills/ rent or mortgage statement/ property tax bill/ renter's or homeowner's statement)
- **PROOF OF UNEARNED INCOME** (SSA, SSI, SS disability, VA benefits, pension/ dividends/ alimony/ unemployment benefits/ etc.)
- **PROOF OF EARNED INCOME** (pay stubs last 30 days'/ gig worker or Self-Employment worksheet)
- **MEDICAL EXPENSES** (Medicare Part B & D premiums/ billing statements or unpaid medical bills/ 90-day Itemized pharmacy print-out)

Through **Museums for All**, those receiving food assistance (SNAP benefits) can gain free or reduced admission to more than 1,000 museums throughout the United States simply by presenting their SNAP EBT card. Admission is \$3 or less for up to four people per EBT card. Visit <https://museums4all.org> to locate participating museums, no registration is required.



Any individual or family who receives income-based public assistance (HEAP/SNAP) in WNY is eligible to apply. **Arts Access** passes can be used at any of our 45 partner locations, all of which believe that the arts belong to everyone. ASI will also provide safe and accessible transportation to and from partner events at the pass holder's request.
