Senior Citizen Exemption Application Instructions

The following information is due to the Assessor's Office no later than **March 1, 2026**:

- 1. Complete & sign the RP-467 application.
- 2. Driver's License for proof of age and residency
- 3. Mobile Home Owners: a copy of your bill of sale must accompany the application.
- 4. Proof of your income earned in **2024** must accompany your application.
 - a. Federal Income Tax Return 1040 Form
 - b. Schedule 1 (if applicable)
- If you do not file a tax return, please provide the following:
 - a. Proof of non-filing from IRS (help with obtaining this available)
 - b. New York State Worksheet
 - c. Social Security 1099 Statement
 - d. Railroad Retirement 1099
 - e. Pension 1099
 - f. Rental Income Statement (if no Schedule E)
 - g. Business Income Statement (if no Schedule C)
 - h. Wage W-2
 - i. Interest 1099
 - j. Dividends 1099
 - k. Annuities 1099
 - I. Gambling Winnings 1099
 - m. Any other 1099 statements

To be eligible for the program your calculated income must be <u>\$48,400</u> or less. Please note: This <u>MUST</u> include full Social Security Benefits.

The application and all applicable income documentation are due to the Assessor's Office no later than March 1, 2026!
