

5 Days - 4 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the one your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1 A morning departure from New York has you traveling to your overnight stop in Beckley, WV where lodging has been arranged for you this evening (pack an overnight bag); dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 2 Following breakfast, check out and continue traveling to Asheville, NC to kick off the holiday season. Upon arrival, you will stop at the Grove Arcade, which features the region's fabulous foods and local crafts for lunch on your own. Later, depart for the Asheville Visitors Center to meet your guide for a historical tour of Asheville which will include a visit to the Folk Art Center. After your tour, check into your hotel for a two-night stay. You will have time to freshen up before dinner. This evening you will enjoy dinner at a popular restaurant in Asheville.
- Day 3 After breakfast, board your motorcoach and depart for the Biltmore Estate. Explore the stories of the Vanderbilt Family, their guests and employees through displays of vintage clothing, accessories, art, furniture and more when visiting the Conservatory. Lunch is on your own at Antter Hill Village, which connects the estate's past and present with dining, shopping and exhibits. The Winery shop has a distinctive portfolio of multi-award winning reds, whites, and roses, This evening's dinner will be at the Stable Cafe on the grounds of the Biltmore Estate and will consist of Southern-style entrees and Appalachian specialties. The highlight of your visit to Asheville will be the Candfelight Christmas Evening Audio Tour of Biltmore House, which is completely illuminated with candles and soft lights as it did when George Vanderbilt officially opened the home on Christmas Eve 1895.
- Day 4 After breakfast, sheck out and return to Beckley, WV. Arrive at Tamarack Marketplace where you can do some shopping and enjoy lunch on your own. Later, you will check into your hotel (pack an overnight bag); dinner is on your own tonight.
- Day 5 Enjoy breakfast, then check out and prepare for your departure home with lasting memories of your trip to Christmas at Biltmore.
