CR-05 - Goals and Outcomes

Progress the jurisdiction has made in carrying out its strategic plan and its action plan. 91.520(a)

This could be an overview that includes major initiatives and highlights that were proposed and executed throughout the program year.

During the 2025 program year, we achieved substantial progress in reaching our planned activity goals of supporting community service needs and reducing the risk of homelessness. Both goals had actual accomplishments that exceeded what was expected.

Additional gains towards the goal of improving housing stock was also evident. While we expected to improve 65 housing units, and only actually assisted 49 with CDBG funds, we assisted an additional 14 units with our HOME funds, for a total of 63 units.

In an effort to improve not only the affordable housing stock in the Town of Cheektowaga, but also revitalize our low-moderate income neighborhoods, we continued our commitment to preserving, improving, and investing in our infrastructure and facilities. While the S. Rossler Avenue project, Willowlawn Parkway Project, and Meadowbrook Parkway projects were postponed due to Town Board concerns relating to project cost and funding, we saw completion of the Cedargrove Tennis Court Resurfacing and the Village of Depew Sidewalk Replacement. It is expected that the 3 postponed projects will see completion in the 2026 program year.

Finally, our goal to affirmatively further fair housing achieved 75% of its goal to assist 90 households by providing comprehensive services for victims of housing discrimination, paralegal counseling to assist in resolving landlord-tenant disputes, providing information on fair housing laws for landlords and tenants, and by making referrals to other housing/human service agencies.

Assess how the jurisdiction’s use of funds, particularly CDBG, addresses the priorities and specific objectives identified in the plan, giving special attention to the highest priority activities identified.

The Town of Cheektowaga’s Annual Plan emphasizes housing, public services, and neighborhood revitalization as primary needs to assist low-moderate income individuals and families. During the 2025 program year, CDBG funding was utilized to create a well-rounded approach to improving the lives of our the Town’s low-mod residents. This approach included not only neighborhood improvement projects, and housing rehabilitation loans, but also public services necessary to support one’s financial well-being and quality of life.

Neighborhood improvement projects and housing rehabilitation loans continue to contribute to the enhancement of neighborhoods and elimination of possible blighting influences. An amount of \$182,725 was expended on the infrastructure projects mentioned above. In addition, CDBG funds totaling approximately \$417,598 were utilized for Housing Rehabilitation projects.

As in past years, in an effort to increase our residents quality of life, CDBG funds were utilized for various public services, including Summer Day Camp Financial Aid, funding to the Cheektowaga Boys & Girls Club, Girl Scouts of WNY, Housing Counseling Services, Fair Housing Education and Counseling, Police Foot Patrols, Domestic Violence Counseling Program, Senior Van Driver, and Village of Depew Senior Center Operations and Programming.

Leveraging

Explain how federal funds leveraged additional resources (private, state and local funds), including a description of how matching requirements were satisfied, as well as how any publicly owned land or property located within the jurisdiction that were used to address the needs identified in the plan.

In the 2025 Program Year, the Town of Cheektowaga was awarded a \$650,000 grant from the New York State Affordable Housing Corporation to be utilized over the 2025 through the 2028 program years. In the past, Cheektowaga has been successful in receiving \$450,000 awards from NYS, however because of the length and nature of our waitlist, we applied for and were awarded an extra \$200,000. These funds are provided to residents in qualified neighborhoods in the form of a 60% grant matching a 40% loan utilizing HOME and CDBG funds. Said grant funds are instrumental in allowing our homeowners to have additional rehab work completed through the program without taking on additional debt in the form of a loan. In addition, these funds serve as a source of the required 25% local Match for HOME funds for the Amherst-Cheektowaga-Tonawanda Consortium.

In an effort to assist a larger number of homeowners, some housing rehabilitation loans require regular monthly loan payments. This allows us to turn funds around quicker and help a larger number of homeowners with their housing rehab needs.

Finally, the Town of Cheektowaga provides office space, utilities, auto maintenance and fuel, accounting services, legal services, and other services at no cost to the Office of Community and Economic Development, which manages the HUD programs for the Town.

Discuss the difference between goals and outcomes and problems encountered in meeting these goals.

The number of units accomplished in our Housing Rehabilitation Loan Program each year is dependent on factors such as the number of applicants, the availability of contractors, and the ability of contractors to get the work done, all of which are out of the control of the Town. However, the Town does conduct outreach to obtain applicants, and we continue to try alternative methods to get the word out about our programs.

During the 2025 program year, we again, saw an uptick in inquiries for assistance through our Housing Rehabilitation Loan Program. As of the end of the 2025 program year, over 200 households were waiting to participate in the program. In addition, our estimated CDBG housing rehabilitation goal was 35 households, between our HOME and CDBG funds we were able to complete 34 rehabilitation projects, with another 35 in process at the end of the program year.

Based on the outcomes of 2025, and the fact that there is a strong need for Housing Rehabilitation Loans based on the current waiting list, program income from both the CDBG and HOME programs will be focused on the Housing Rehabilitation Loan Program.

Narrative Information

Families are served through Town of Cheektowaga programs on a first-come, first-served basis and the range of income types varies from year to year. We continue to stress our Mobile Home Rehab Program and Owner-Occupied Rehab Program to reach the poorer homeowners in the Town and our mobile home parks. We have and will again participate in the Senior Star mailing with the Town Assessor’s office to reach our seniors, many of whom are low-income.

Evaluate the jurisdiction's progress in meeting its specific objectives for reducing and ending homelessness through:

Reaching out to homeless persons (especially unsheltered persons) and assessing their individual needs

The Town of Cheektowaga is aware that there are people considered homeless living in Cheektowaga. Occasionally, the Cheektowaga Police Department come across people who are living in tents in wooded areas of the Town. Others that the police interact with also identify themselves as being homeless. Although it would be hard to quantify the number of homeless in Cheektowaga, there have been documented incidents where the Police Department has assisted people that they interact with in finding safe housing. Assistance has ranged from transporting these individuals to the Matt Urban Center, to linking them with service providers in the community who can assist with emergency needs, both mental and physical. In addition, the Police Department partners with Endeavor Health Services to provide behavioral health and crisis intervention services. The role of this individual is to not only provide additional expertise to police officers when responding to calls, but to further assist with linking individuals to necessary services, and to follow-up with people who have had interactions with the police to determine what steps can be taken for them to take positive steps forward.

Addressing the emergency shelter and transitional housing needs of homeless persons

The Town continues to participate in the region's homeless planning strategies and meetings with homeless service agencies. In addition, Town staff in the Office of Community Development continue to collaborate with all regional social service agencies to stay up to date on existing service gaps, and as a result target funding more appropriately.

Helping low-income individuals and families avoid becoming homeless, especially extremely low-income individuals and families and those who are: likely to become homeless after being discharged from publicly funded institutions and systems of care (such as health care facilities, mental health facilities, foster care and other youth facilities, and corrections programs and institutions); and, receiving assistance from public or private agencies that address housing, health, social services, employment, education, or youth needs

Through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's Section 8 Existing and Project-Based Programs, vouchers are provided to low-income renters, thereby reducing their housing costs. This program is administered throughout the County of Erie by Belmont Housing Resources for WNY. In addition, it is our goal through social service agencies receiving CDBG funds, to provide linkages to assistance before shelter is needed.

Helping homeless persons (especially chronically homeless individuals and families, families with children, veterans and their families, and unaccompanied youth) make the transition to permanent housing and independent living, including shortening the period of time that individuals and families experience homelessness, facilitating access for homeless individuals and families to affordable housing units, and preventing individuals and families who were recently homeless from becoming homeless again

The Town offers a variety of programs to assist low-moderate income residents to remain in their primary residence. A variety of counseling services are provided through Housing Opportunities Made Equal, Belmont Housing Resources for WNY, Parachute Credit Counseling, and the Western New York Law Center to address housing needs and make changes to financial conditions to prevent foreclosure and homelessness.

In addition, reducing housing costs can make housing more affordable and thereby prevent homelessness. Community Development Block Grant and HOME Investment Partnership funds have been used to provide low-moderate income homeowners with low or no interest loans to correct minor and major deficiencies and/or code violations on their homes. Using Community Development Block Grant funds, the Town, in cooperation with Supportive Services Corporation, also provides a weatherization program to homeowners for a variety of energy saving improvements. These programs provide low-moderate income homeowners in the Town the funds necessary to make improvements and retain home ownership.

Actions taken to remove or ameliorate the negative effects of public policies that serve as barriers to affordable housing such as land use controls, tax policies affecting land, zoning ordinances, building codes, fees and charges, growth limitations, and policies affecting the return on residential investment. 91.220 (j); 91.320 (i)

As previously noted, the Town of Cheektowaga took the first steps towards mitigating restrictive public policy in 2021 by adopting a Comprehensive Plan. Since the adoption of this plan the Town has been engaged on multiple fronts to combat the negative effects of public policy, considering the effects of both regulations in their infancy and policy aging unchecked.

Predominantly the most notable steps that have been taken are the Town's consideration of a Pro-Housing Designation, migrating to a more robust property management software program, drafting a new fee schedule, and being awarded funding for a phased re-write of the local zoning code.

Reviewing these initiatives in more depth, the Pro-Housing Community designation is a part of the Pro-Housing Community program born out New York State's Homes and Community (HCR) initiative to help preserve, protect, and develop affordable housing in economically vibrant communities. The Town sought this designation in late 2024 with partial board support and was unfortunately defeated. However, interest in seeking this designation once again has re-surfaced. Establishing this designation would at minimum open stronger scoring opportunities for those seeking to invest within the community and using appropriately designated state funding programs.

An older but relevant on-going change is the Town's shift to a more robust property management system. This software system will go live in the Summer of 2026 and change the accessibility of government across multiple departments. Allowing residents and stakeholders to easily access permits, licensing, file complaints & requests, apply fee payments, and schedule inspections via this module 24/7.

In conjunction with the changeover of the Town's property management software, the Building & Plumbing Department has drafted a re-vamped fee schedule for construction permit and plan review costs. If adopted after public consideration, the fee schedule will structure alleviation where appropriate and account for inflation of service costs.

Lastly, the Town was awarded in 2025 by Erie County Department of Environment and Planning, funding for a planning and zoning initiative. Currently the contract to receive such funding is still under negotiation. However, upon receipt, this funding will go towards phase 01 meant to establish the Galleria-Thruway District as identified within the Comprehensive Plan.

This phase 01 initiative is to start with a zoning code update in an area that is an economic driver, centrally located, and made up of a unique collective of land uses. Intentions are to broaden the land-uses, including the incorporation of housing to give more flexibility, and predictability of development via the use of design and architectural standards. Upon completion of this phase 01 update, the next phase would be to focus on the remainder of the Town.

Actions taken to address obstacles to meeting underserved needs. 91.220(k); 91.320(j)

The Town of Cheektowaga continues to work with the Cheektowaga Community Collaborative to identify unmet needs and identify solutions for our residents. Regular meetings are held to discuss changing community needs and how they can be addressed through the various social service partner agencies.

The Town's housing rehabilitation loan program has funding to address accessibility issues for the elderly or for persons with physical disabilities. Such funds may cover the addition of wheelchair ramps, handicap accessible bathrooms, kitchens, doorways, and/or ingress/egress modifications. 1 of these projects were completed in the 2025 program year.

Actions taken to reduce lead-based paint hazards. 91.220(k); 91.320(j)

The Town of Cheektowaga continues to take several steps toward the elimination of lead-based paint hazards by implementing procedures, including educating recipient homeowners on the dangers of lead-based paint hazards, and its prevention, through onsite distribution of federally approved pamphlets and brochures.

In addition, all residential properties receiving rehabilitation assistance through the CDBG or HOME programs are screened by inspectors as to age of the structure, amount of peeling paint on the property, emergency work status, and whether or not a painted surface will be affected by the proposed rehabilitation work. After screening, a determination is made as to whether the subject property is required to be inspected for lead paint hazards. In most cases, a Risk Assessment is performed.

The hazards identified by the Risk Assessment are incorporated into the work write-up for the project and are addressed by a certified contractor through either interim controls or abatement, depending on the size of the job. Community Development Inspectors have been properly trained in identifying and dealing with lead paint hazards. Contractors participating in the Town's Rehabilitation Loan Program are required to become certified in order to assure the availability of qualified, trained, and competitive rehabilitation contractors.

During the past fiscal year, the Town of Cheektowaga evaluated, and where necessary, remediated lead contamination in 17 residential structures rehabilitated with CDBG and HOME funds.

Actions taken to reduce the number of poverty-level families. 91.220(k); 91.320(j)

It is the Town's belief that in order to reduce the number of poverty-level families, a well-rounded approach must be taken. As a result, the Town utilizes local social service organizations and Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to provide services such as housing and budget counseling, various programs for children, both during the school year, and during summer break, additional police foot patrols, senior services, counseling for domestic violence victims, and tenant/landlord

counseling. In addition, CDBG and HOME Investment Partnership funds are used to aid in the maintenance of safe and affordable dwelling units.

Actions taken to develop institutional structure. 91.220(k); 91.320(j)

It is important for government, non-profit, and for-profit entities to work together to provide resources efficiently and effectively to residents, especially low-income residents. The Office of Community Development has established working relationships with the Homeless Alliance of WNY, Erie County Departments of Social Services and Senior Services, Western New York Independent Living, Belmont Housing Resources for WNY, Housing Opportunities Made Equal and others that provide housing and services to special populations. In addition, Community Development works closely with other Town departments including Youth & Recreation, Senior Services, Building & Plumbing, the Town Assessor, and the Law Department, to ensure comprehensive municipal services to residents.

Actions taken to enhance coordination between public and private housing and social service agencies. 91.220(k); 91.320(j)

To improve coordination between public and private housing and social service agencies, the Town's offices of Community Development, Senior Services, and Youth Services continue to participate in the Cheektowaga Community Collaborative. This group continues to meet on a regular basis with local non-profit agencies and representatives from the local educational community (school districts and Villa Maria College) to detect potential gaps in services and educate each other about available service solutions.

Identify actions taken to overcome the effects of any impediments identified in the jurisdictions analysis of impediments to fair housing choice. 91.520(a)

The 2025 Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing was created jointly through the efforts of the County of Erie, City of Buffalo, the Amherst-Cheektowaga-Tonawanda HOME Consortium, and the Town of Hamburg. In the report, it was determined that the Town of Cheektowaga currently has zero census tracts where the tract-level poverty rate is at least double the Townwide poverty rate (9.2%), meaning the Town has no concentrated areas of poverty. However, data does show most tracts in the northwestern portion of the Town adjacent to the City of Buffalo are categorized as racially or ethnically concentrated areas, suggesting that residential and housing market dynamics are still producing racial and ethnic segregation in Cheektowaga. As a result, it was recommended the Town focus its affirmatively furthering fair housing activities in these areas.

In an effort to continue to improve the quality of life in the northwestern part of Town, we continue to seek and utilize grant funds from the New York State Affordable Housing Corporation, which are provided to eligible homeowners in conjunction with HOME and CDBG funds. Said funds are given in the form a 40% loan, 60% grant format. In addition, CDBG Funds continue to be invested in these areas for infrastructure improvements in an effort to enhance safety and outward appearance in these

neighborhoods.

CR-40 - Monitoring 91.220 and 91.230

Describe the standards and procedures used to monitor activities carried out in furtherance of the plan and used to ensure long-term compliance with requirements of the programs involved, including minority business outreach and the comprehensive planning requirements

The Town monitors its sub-recipients on an on-going basis, utilizing a project/activity checklist and a project control form to ensure compliance with program regulations. In addition, staff members regularly review and update program policies and procedures and our sub-recipient manual to improve the management of our programs.

The Community Development Office also provides close oversight of several of our sub-recipients, including the Village of Depew, Village of Sloan, and the Cheektowaga Economic Development Corporation. Such close oversight consists of Town staff involvement with project planning and continuous conversations throughout project execution.

In response to minority business outreach, on an annual basis when trying to recruit new contractors to be a part of our program, the Office of Community Development obtains the New York State certified minority contractors list and mails letters requesting said contractors participate in our program.

The Town notifies citizens of the availability of the draft CAPER report through a notice published in the Cheektowaga Bee, the Town's official newspaper, and on Town Social Media sites. The Cheektowaga Bee is available free to the public in libraries, public buildings, commercial establishments, and at various street corner boxes.

The notice in the Cheektowaga Bee advises the public of the two annual public hearings regarding the Community Development programs and of the availability of the draft CAPER for review in both local libraries, the Town Clerk's Office, the Villages of Depew and Sloan Clerk's Office, and the Community Development Office. Public access to the CAPER is enhanced by posting this document on the Town's website for easy access at www.tocny.org under the Community Development Department page.

During the 2025 program year, it was brought to our attention that one of our low-income Senior Housing complexes was experiencing fiscal constraints with some much-needed upgrades to common areas of the buildings. As a result, CDBG revolving loan funds from the Cheektowaga Economic Development Corporation, as well as the Office of Community Development were reallocated to provide a 0% interest loan in the amount of \$470,000 for necessary upgrades to the parking facilities, sidewalks, heating systems, and elevators. It is expected the planning and execution of such upgrades will take place in the 2026 program year.
