- *Assistance is provided in the form of a secured loan*
- *Assistance is limited to a maximum of \$35,000 for each new job created*
- *Minimum Loan Amount is \$10,000, there is no maximum, but is limited based on availability of funds*
- *Assistance must be sufficient to make project feasible*

Eligibility Requirements

- *Principal business activity must be located within the Town of Cheektowaga, Village of Sloan, or Village of Depew west of Transit Road*
 - *Eligible types of businesses include manufacturing, warehousing, wholesale distribution, and certain retail or service trades*
- Funding for MICROENTERPRISES may also be considered.*
- *Assistance must directly result in the creation of full-time job opportunities, of which at least 51% are made available to low/moderate income persons.*

Funds Can Be Used For

- *training*
- *the acquisition of fixed assets including, but not limited to equipment, machinery, and/or real estate*
- *current assets including inventory, receivables, and permanent working capital*
